

A group of youths made the grisly discovery adjacent to h Avenue and Williams Road on State Road Department property in a rural area east of Hillsborough County.

Major Frank Bowen of the police department said there were indications of a struggle near the stacks of trash, bricks and broken block pilings about 50 feet from where the body of Bland S. Stewart, 48, was found.

IN ANOTHER development, a cab union spokesman said yesterday that Stewart had been threatened by a non-union driver while he was picketing about four days ago.

Stewart was reported missing Thursday a day on the job for United. His blood stained c later Thursday by police officers who were another United Cab Co. vehicle that later was for water.

Police Sgt. Ralph Mills said cause of death known until an autopsy is performed.
