## APPRAISERS' ESTIMATE OF THE AMOUNT OF THE WIDOW'S AWARD

\*Such sum of money as the appraisers may deem reasonable for the proper support of herself and her minor children for the period of one year after the death of the testator or intestate in a manner suited to her condition in life, taking into account the condition of the estate of deceased.  
A written notice must be sent widow stating the amount of her allowance which she can take in money or in personal property of deceased at appraised value.
