

MRS. STULTZ PASSES AWAY

Former Grade School Teacher
Dies At Dixon; Mrs. Chas.
Pavey Passes Away

WAS WELL KNOWN

Mrs. Douglass G. Stultz of Franklin Grove, a former resident of DeKalb and at one time a teacher in the grade school system of this city, passed away in the Dixon hospital this morning at 2:30 o'clock. An operation performed a week ago last Thursday for the removal of a goitre so weakened Mrs. Stultz that she succumbed this morning.

Phenie Bannister was born on a farm west of DeKalb, June 2, 1890 the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harwood Bannister. She was educated in the DeKalb schools and attended the Normal schools, graduating to take a position in the school at Franklin Grove. After teaching for three years in that town she came to DeKalb and taught in the Haish and Ellwood schools until 1922, leaving to take a position in a school in Montana.

On June 27, 1923 she was united in marriage to Douglass G. Stultz and since then has considered Franklin Grove her home.

Besides a grieving husband Mrs. Stultz leaves to mourn her passing three brothers, Edwin of Tacoma, Washington, Samuel, and Charles of DeKalb. Funeral services are to be held from the home in Franklin Grove Monday with interment in the cemetery there.
