Johnson**

DEKALB — Mrs. Irma C. Johnson, 82, of 326 Sycamore Road, DeKalb, died Nov. 7, 1970 in the DeKalb Public Hospital.

The former Irma Holmgren was born Sept. 26, 1888 in Plano, the daughter of August and Hilma Molander Holmgren. She was married to Neo C. Johnson in Geneva on May 16, 1917.

Mrs. Johnson graduated from St. Lukes School of Nursing, Chicago, in 1913 and from 1914 until 1917 served as public health nurse in DeKalb. From 1932 until 1955 they lived at their farm home in Esmond until moving to DeKalb in 1955.

She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in DeKalb, and of the Women's Society of Christian Service of the church, also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary.

Her husband and nieces and nephews survive.

She was preceded by her parents, three brothers and a sister.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 10 at the Wirtz-Roche Funeral Home, with the Rev. Osborne Smedstad officiating. Interment will be in Fairview cemetery.
