

**YOUNG MAN
PASSES AWAY**

Roy Holmgren Died at St. Joseph's
Hospital, Elgin Last
Evening.

The sad news was received here last evening of the death of Roy Holmgren which occurred last evening at about eight o'clock at St. Joseph's hospital Elgin, where he was taken for treatment. Mr. Holmgren had been suffering with Bright's disease for a period of several years, and though his relatives knew that he could not recover his death was a terrible shock to them. The deceased was born about twenty-one years ago at Plano and he was the youngest son of Mrs. Hilma Holmgren. He received his education in the schools here graduating from the Township High school, and later studying at a business college. He was employed as a stenographer until his health interfered with his duties. Mr. Holmgren was known throughout the city as a young man of sterling character and he has hundreds of friends who will sympathise with the bereaved relatives.

He leaves besides his mother his brothers, Wesley of Washington, and Adolph of DeKalb and sisters, Miss Erma who is a nurse at St. Luke's hospital, Chicago and his sister Miss Ethel who resides here.

The remains were brought from Elgin this afternoon at two-thirty o'clock, where the relatives were called last night, and the funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon from the home on Sycamore road at 2:30. The remains will be taken to Plano Sunday morning for burial. The funeral will be public and friends may view the remains between the hours of ten and twelve tomorrow morning.
