In the name of God Amen, I Isaac Reed Sen'r of Monongalia County & State of Virginia do make and constitute this my will and testament as followeth, Item 1st my will and desire is that all my just debts should paid out of my estate, Item 2nd my will & desire is that my beloved wife Rebecca Reed as long as sheg shall remain my widow shall have one bed & bedding two cows two pigs to continue the property of wife during her natural life and widowhood, Item 3rd my will and desire is that my son Nathaniel Reed should have the piece of land he now lives on with the adjacent lines between himself and me, Item 4th my will and desire is that my sons Isaac and Amos Reed should have all the land on the south side of the old glade Road to be equally divided between them, Item 5th my will and desire is that my sons Thos. & Stephen Reed have all the land North of old glade Joining Nathaniel Reed Runer & others to be equally divided between them Item 6th my will and desire is that all my estate shall be sold such horses cows hogs sheep household gitchen furniture & farming utentials and be divide between my daughters that is to say fifty dollars more to my daughter Elizabeth Wallace and Jenima Faucett one hundred dollars and Rebecca Reed one hundred Dollars & Rachel Reed one hundred dollars, Item 7th my will and desire is that if there should not be perishable property to sell to the amount of the sum left to my daughter Elizabeth Jenima Rebecca & Rachel Reed that my sons Nathaniel Reed Isaac Reed Amos Reed Thos. Reed and Stephens Reed should make it up each one his proportion, Item 8th I do by these presents appoint make and constitute my two sons Nathaniel Reed & Thomas Reed my lawful Executors of this my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18th Oct. one thousand eight hundred & twenty one. In the name of God Amen the second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four I Jesse Burrows of Monongalia county and State of Virginia considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and meaning thanks be to God for the same do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following namely: First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Phoebe Burrows all my personal estate at my death and further I give her all my notes that I have owing to me I appoint Phoebe Burrows to be my executrix and William Miller to be my executor this my last will and testament hereby revoking and disannulling all former wills by me made. In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand & seal above date signed sealed published and declared by the above named Jesse Burrows to be his last will and testament in the presence of us, who at his request and in his presence have sub-

scribed our names as witnesses thereunto.

Posters survey and running from s'd corner a straight course to a lick on the bank of Scots run and thence to run a cross the bottom to the bank on the left hand of the wright hand fork of Scots run and with the bank up said run to my line and with the same to the beginning also all my intrent in two hundred and seventy five acrs of land taken up by Joseph Park and the subscriber together with my personal property to be disposed of either by public or private sale as my executur may think best and secondly I give to my wife the residue of my real estate during her life and after her dissese to be divided amongst my children and lastly I do appoint my friend Nicholas Shane Executor of this my last will and testament hereby
