IOHN KEY OF VIRGINIA

John Key, born about 1696, settled Albemarle County, Virginia. He married Martha Tandy (?), had son, John, Jr., Martin, Henry, Mary, who married Robert Dalton, and probably other children. John, Jr., is said to have married Susannah Watts and had John Key III, who married Agnes Witt, and George, Price, Judith, Joseph, Barbara Ann, Mildred, William Waller, Martin and Elizabeth Key. (See

Witt family, also census report, John Key's widow.)

John Walter Key, son of John and Agnes (Witt) Key, born May 11, 1751, served in the Revolutionary War in Virginia. In 1787, he, with his brother Joseph, and sister Elizabeth, wife of Benjamin Watts, removed to Georgia. John settled in Franklin County, where he remained until his death in 1827. He married Virginia "Jennie" Wade, an orphan. George W. Key, of Jourdanton, Texas, a great grandson of John W. Key, states "that his father often told him that his grand mother was noted for her physical strength and prowess, that she could stand inside of a half bushel measure and shoulder two bushels of wheat."

Key, who married Delilia Embry.

John T. Thomas, born 1808, Georgia, died April 21, 1897, Lamar Co., Ala., m. Sarah Thomas, grand daughter of Mr.? Key, who lived near Augusta, Ga. Their children: Newton, m. Miss Bean Thomas; Jennie, m. Shirrod Holley; Simeon B., b. Nov. 29, 1834, died Nov. 3, 1907, married 1st Nancy Copelan, 2nd Margaret Graves; Jane, m. James Chandler; Lethia, m. Thomas H. Finch; Christopher Columbus, m. Martha Malloy; George Key, m. Rebecca Copelan; Frank P., m. Molly?; Wm., m. Mary Jane Waldroup. No issue.
