Oct 1789).

THE NUTHALL FAMILY

1. CHARLES NUTTALL of Crowelomme, Bury, Lancashire, died c1562. Lindsay Nuttall states he was most likely either a son of Charles Nuttall of Nuttall, d. 1557, Lower Tottington Parish, Bury Parish, Lancashire, or a son of Christopher Nuttall of Newhall Hey, Upper Tottington Township, Bury Parish, Lancashire, who d. c1526.

At any rate, Charles, the decedent of 1562, was the father of (A): CHARLES.

2. CHARLES NUTTALL or NUTTOW, d. 1581, of Aveley and Wennington, Essex, was originally from Bury, Lancashire, and was a son of Charles (1) Nuttall (d. c1562) of Crow Lumb (Crawwelomme), Bury Salford Hundred, Lancashire. Charles, Jr., m. (possibly as a 2nd wife) Margaret (N) Taynter, widow of William Taynter who was still living in 1575. Margaret m., as her third husband, Thomas Joslin, d. 1605 of Rocheford, Essex. She herself died 1619. Her maiden name may have been Bachiler as Thomas Joslin named Margerie or Margaret Bachiler as a kinswoman of his wife.

Joslin's will mentions his wife Margaret's children: William Taynter, James Nuttall (her second son, and Charles Nuttall.

Charles died leaving a will which mentioned the following children (but only Charles and James can definitely be identified as sons by his second wife) (A): ELIZABETH, m. by 1581 (N) Payne; JOHN, under 21; MARY, under 21; (by Margaret (N): CHARLES, under 21; and JAMES.

3. JAMES NUTTALL, Gent., of Rocheford and Hockley, Essex, b. c1576/79, d. 1637, son of Charles Nuttow (2) (Nuttall), married Jane Wiseman. James Nuttall, Curate of Hockley, Essex, widower, "wife dead two years," m. 2nd Hester Paschall of South Benfleet, Essex, at St. Bartholomew the Great, London, on 24 June 1624. James d. leaving a will probated July 1637.

James and Jane were the parents of (A): THOMAS, b. c1600, m. by license from the Bishop of London dated 6 Nov 1622, Elizabeth Letton of Basseldon, Essex; JAMES, attended Oriel College, Oxford, 1617-1620; MARY, b. c1603, m. with consent of her father, by lic. 3 Feb 1628/9, John de Cerf, clerk of St. Catherine Coleman, London; CHARLES, Gent., possibly the Charles living at Staple Inn, in Dec 1641; MARTHA, b. 1613, m. by lic. dated 21 Oct 1637, Richard Wythe, 28, bachelor, of St. Martin-in-the Fields, London; FRANCES, b. 1614, by lic. dated 27 May 1635 at Canewden, Essex, m. Richard Bouchier,
