NOTE the following from Hartford Times Nov. 4, 1963, and the discrepancy in the name of the father of John Hitchcock who married Mary Franklin (Richard in the article following, Robert in the material above).

HITCHCOCK. To those researchers interested in ancestry of Luke Hitchcock who mar. Elizabeth Gibbons, offer following from Parish Records, Wiltshire, England.

Richard Hiscokes, b. abt. 1556 of All Cannings, Wiltshire, Eng.; d. there Dec. 1, 1587; name of wife unknown. Chil. were: Margaret, chris. Feb. 1, 1582-3, mar. Oct. 9, 1609, John Filpe; John, b. 1586 (see below)

John Hiscokes (Hitchcock) chris. All Cannings, July 1, 1586, d. there June 12, 1629; mar. at St. Peters, Marlborough, Wiltshire, Eng. Feb. 7, 1614, Mary Franklin, b. abt. 1590 of Kinnett, Wiltshire.

Luke Hitchcock b. St. Peters, Marlborough, Eng. abt. 1614, d. Nov. 1 or June 1659; mar. Elizabeth Gibbons of Hartford, Conn., b. abt. 1618, d. Apr. 25, 1696. She mar. 2d, Oct. 2, 1661, William Warriner and mar 3d, Spt. 17, 1678, Joseph Baldwin.

Mr. Fred W. (Fern Thatcher) Smith, 1963, also sends the following references: Cutter's Massachusetts Families, Vol. 2, p. 1211 for children of Deacon John Hitchcock and Hannah Chapin Hitchcock. Hitchcock genealogy compiled for the N. E. Register, Vol. 40, p. 307, by H. G. Cleveland, states: "Luke Hitchcock, brother probably to Matthias Hitchcock, New Haven, 1639, place and time of birth unknown, Freeman 1644, removed to Wethersfield, Ct., To move to Hadley he signed agreement, but died Nov. 1, 1659, leaving wife, Elizabeth and 3 ch, John, Hannah and Luke. Only 8 ch are listed for John and Hannah Chapin Hitchcock from this source the first child who died same day as born not included." C-2392-(1) Hartford Times, Nov. 15, 1958: Hitchcock-Gibbons F. W. S. Elizabeth Gibbons—a sister of William Gibbons of Hartford, Conn. She married 1st Luke Hitchcock, 2nd William Warriner, 3rd Joseph Baldwin. She came from England with her brother, William, who was sent in 1646 to prepare a settlement for his employer, George Wylet.....References: Lt. Samuel Smith-His Childred and Descendants by J. W.
