

**MOSES** Simmons Plymouth, one of the first comers, arr. in the Fortune 1621, b. at Leyden, and bearing the Dutch name of Symonson or Simonson, but early shorten. his name to the first two syllab.; prob. brot. w. but no ch. is kn. exc. **Moses**, and Thomas[1], wh. may both have been b. here. He sett. at Duxbury, was one of the orig. purch. of Dartmouth and props. of Bridgewater, and of Middleboroug, but did not rem. to either.
