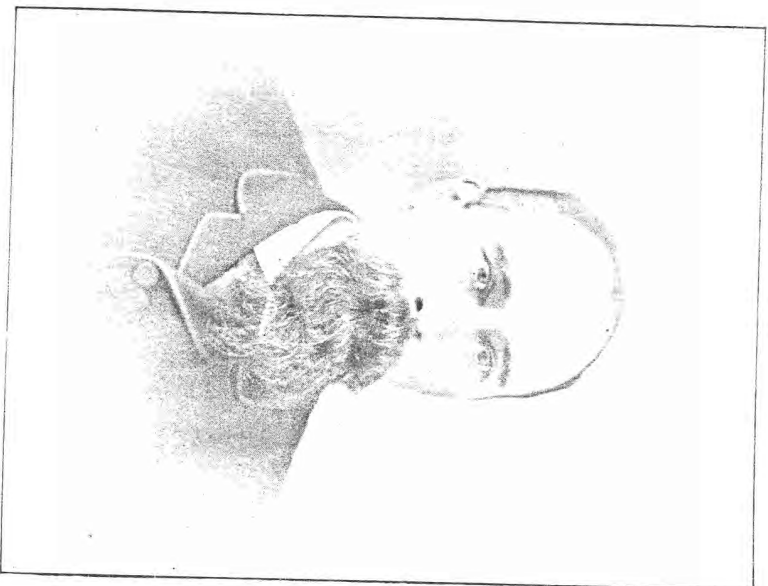
THE KILLAM FAMILY.

Augustine or Austin Killam, with his wife Alice, born in 1597, and their family, sailed from Yarmouth, Norfolk Co., England, in May, 1637, and arrived at Salem the same summer. A little later they were at Dedham and Chelmsford, but in 1638 they finally settled at Wenham, Mass., where they both died in 1667, Mr. Killam on the 5th June, and his wife on the 1st July.

Austin Killam is supposed to have come from the West Riding of Yorkshire, where the parish of Killam still exists, near Beverly, the principal market town of that part of England, and it is said that there the Killam family has been seated since the time of William the Conqueror.

The figures after the names in the following table denote the number of generations that the families are known to have been settled in Yorkshire previous to 1665:

Thomas Kilham was a soldier of Major Appleton's company in King Philip's war, 1675. He lived in Wenham till 1701, when he purchased of Zernbabel Endercott, of Boxford, the farm in the latter town originally granted to his grandfather Governor John Endercott. Mr. Kilham immediately moved to this farm, now owned and occupied by the sixth generation of his descendants.

John Endercott (1558-1665), deputy governor 6 years and governor 14 years, married 18th Aug., 1630, Elizabeth (Ludlow) Gibson. Their son, Dr. Zernbabel Endercott, born about 1636, a physician of Salem, had by his wife Mary a son, Zernbabel Endercott, born 1664. He lived on the Boxford farm till he sold it to Thomas Kilham. In July, 1690, he married Grace Symonds, and died in 1706. Their daughter Grace, born 10th April, 1703, married Samuel Kilham.

The name Joanna Parrot above, so appears in the Wenham records, but it is said that the lady's name was properly Perrot, and that she came from Caspe to Ipswich, and thence to Wenham. The Perrot families of the last century were among the oldest and most numerous of Lower Canada (now Quebec), and more than one hundred of the name, previous to 1800, are recorded in the Abbey Tanqueray's Genealogical Dictionary. No Parrot family can be found in the records of Wenham, Ipswich or adjacent towns. The lady's name originally was, doubtless, Jeanne Perrot.

In 1766 John Kilham, with his wife Joanna and their two sons, Abraham and John, removed from Wenham to Yarmouth and settled at the head of tide water of the Chegoggin river, where he had a grant of land, which, with other lands in the township, made a total of 983 acres. The date of his death does not appear, but Mrs. Kilham died probably at Chegoggin, at the residence of her youngest daughter, Joanna, on the 24th of April, 1835, aged 97 years.

For more than a hundred years there have

been Killam families in King's county, N. S., and in New Brunswick. Under date of 25th January, R. W. Killam, of Somerset, King's county, writes :

"I would state that it has been handed down to us, my great grandfather, whose first name I do not know, came from England to Halifax, married there, and when the regiment was moved, he left his wife and two sons, John and Anasa, behind him, and soon after died in England; that soon after his death his wife gave birth to a third son, and in her grief and loneliness called this little boy her "comfort," and continuing to do so, his name became established as Comfort Killam. The same, I suppose, was the ancestor of the Killam family in New Brunswick, a number of whom are opulent men. The son Anasa, after some wandering, settled in King's county, N. S. His wife was Elizabeth Sandford, a godly woman. They had six sons and two daughters — Benjamin, Solomon, Andrew, Ziphron, Daniel, Anasa, Sarah and Elizabeth, whose families have about all scattered except Benjamin's and Anasa's, whose families make up about all the names in these parts."

And John Killam, of North Kingston, writes on the 26th January, that the grandfather of Anasa E. Killam, of Moncton, N. B., ex-M. P., and now Inspector of Bridges and Buildings for the Intercolonial Railway, was named Cyprian Killam, and that his great-grandfather was an officer in the British army, who removed from Connecticut just after the American Revolution, and settled in Sackville, N. B.
