Thomas Wilford of Wylford, Esquire of Hartridge in the Parish of Cranbrook, County Kent, was a son of James Wilsford and wife Elizabeth Betenham. Before 1514 he married Elizabeth Colepeper, da. of Walter Colepeper and wife Anne Aucher of Bedgebury. She died before 1532, leaving two sons and eight daughters.

1. Cecilia (or Cecily) Wilford or Wilsford married on 19 Feb. 1559, Edwin Sandys (1516—8 Aug. 1588), Archbishop of York. She was his second wife. Her will was probated at Canterbury on 17 Jan. 1611. She was buried under a tomb at Wodham Ferrars, Essex, and a picture of it, of her, and of her husband have appeared in *The Virginia Magazine of History and Biography* (Vol. XXIX, pages 235, 232, and 231, respectively.)
 - a. Anne Sandys was born 21 Jan. 1570. She married Sir William Barnes (1568-1619) of Woolwich, Kent, a Member of the Virginia Company of London. He was a son of Sir George Barnes the Younger and wife Anne Gerrard.
