In 1796, he sold to Abraham Douthit all or part at least of the land inherited from John Douthit Sr and gave a part of his lands back to the Moravians; in 1798, Moravian records reported him "gone to the new land"; and that is all we know.)

- m No NC marriage has been found for John (1777-1851/2) -- finding one would help a great deal, because John seems to have been always in places where records were fragmentary (Sullivan c IN had a fire in 1850) and the result is that we have a rather slithery image of John and his family; they are found in Sullivan c 1840 census; Piankeshaw chapter DAR, recording Bible and Cem Rec of Floyd c IN, refers to him as a "soldier of the War of 1812, whose grandfather was John Douthitt Sr of Rowan c NC, Rev patriot"; John's service in 1812 was as a pvt, 7th rgt (Pearson's) NC militia; one line of descendants names his wife as Nancy Ellen White, but the only census record in which she is named is that of 1850, Sullivan c, where she is plainly Mary; these descendants also know John as John Jackson

JAMES⁴ DOUTHIT (John³, James², John)

We know so little of this JAMES DOUTHIT -- second son and child of JOHN (1777-1851/2) and NANCY/Mary () DOUTHIT that we might almost doubt his existence except for an affidavit of descent made in 1910 and recorded in Sullivan c IN Deed Releases under date of 1954, by James L. Douthitt; this document places James as an older son of Sullivan c John (1777-1851/2), who preceded his father in death, as did James's wife also. In 1830 there is a James Douthit (b btn 1800 and 1810) in the Rowan c NC census listed btn Ira and James's and Ira's father John; there is an otherwise unaccounted for marriage in Rowan c NC, also, Aug 1828, James Douthit to Elizabeth Ellis; in the 1830 Rowan c hsehd of James Douthit there is a wife and another young male, aged 15 to 19 (in addition to James, who is 20-29) and a female under 5 years; this census profile does not conflict with James L. Douthitt's affidavit, which gives James two daughters Sullivan c's James L. Douthitt's affidavit gives James's death as earlier than father John's -- no precise date: this James is not identifiable in the 1840 census of either IN or NC; there is nothing in the affidavit to indicate that he came to IN; the DAR's Bible and Cem recs says that four sons of John came to IN with him; we know, however, that Skidmore was in John's hsehd in 1850: that makes five; James may have remained in NC
