

## Services For Mrs. Molander To Be Thursday

Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:00 o'clock from the Nelson and Ronan chapel for Mrs. Orrilla J. Molander, whose death occurred on Monday evening at the St. Anthony hospital, Rockford, following a fall in which her hip was fractured. Burial will be in the Fairview cemetery.
