

Mrs. Winter, 84, Lenzburg, Dies of Pneumonia

Mrs. Augusta Winter, 84-year-old former resident of south of Lenzburg, died at 9 o'clock this morning in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alice Kinzel, Marissa, where she had been residing the past three months. Death was due to complications brought on by her advanced age and followed a short siege of pneumonia.

Mrs. Winter was born in Germany July 21, 1862, a daughter of the late Erman and Wilhelmina Huth, nee Pannier, also natives of Germany. She came to the United States with her parents when she was but 18 months old. On March 15, 1883, she married William A. Winter and resided with him on a farm south of Lenzburg. Her husband, a retired farmer, died November 23, 1918, and three years later Mrs. Winter moved to Lenzburg where she had resided until her illness.

Surviving besides the daughter at whose home she died are a daughter, Anna, wife of Henry Orth, Lenzburg; three brothers, Fred Huth, Freeburg; John Huth, Lenzburg, and Herman Huth, New Athens; two sisters, Mrs. Mary Hessick, New Athens, and Mrs. Anna Schaller, Belleville; seven grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren. A daughter, Mrs. Nora Beimfohr, a brother, William Huth, and a sister, Mrs. Minnie Eckert, preceded her in death.
